Crab Cook-Off

Rules & Regulations

1. Crab must be locally caught (Puget Sound) on a recreational license.
2. Crab may be Red Rock or Dungeness (or combination).
3. Written list of all ingredients must be next to entry. Cards provided.
4. Contestants may enter one dish in each category.
5. Each dish is a separate entry and must be prepared by the contestant.
6. Each entry must be plated for presentation. Please provide ladle if needed.
7. Plates, sample cups and plastic-ware will be provided. Each contestant is responsible for all cooking and preparation utensils.
8. Cook-Off Registration closes at NOON, Saturday, August 19th. Entry fee is \$10 per dish entered. (Obtain entry forms at the Harbormaster Office)
9. Judging begins at 12:30 pm; all entries must be in place by 12:25 pm.
10. Categories of Entries are:
 - Soup
 - Crab Cakes
 - Dip or Spreads
 - Specialty Dish
11. There will be two rounds of judging: First, by a panel of guest judges for Top Choice of each category. Second will be a *People's Choice Award* for favorite overall dish.
12. Judging will be based on Presentation, Originality and Taste.
13. Awards will be presented starting around 4:00 pm on the Main Stage:
 - Judges' Awards: Top Choice for each Category (4 prizes = 1 per category)
 - *People's Choice Award*: \$100 cash to overall voted favorite dish.
