Camp Site Fees - to be paid in advance of your stay:

- \$25 With Power & Water - includes dump fee
- \$20 No Power or Water
- \$5 Dump Fee (Stand-alone charge if not camping)

Camping at the Fairgrounds Overview:

- Camp spaces are on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Gates are closed to the campgrounds from Dusk to Dawn.
- You are limited to no more than fourteen nights within a 30 day period.
- Check-out is no later than 1:00pm - at which time all personal property should be removed.
- Campsite should be well kept - with exterior space clear of clutter and personal belongs strewn about. Clothes lines are prohibited.
- Camping is only allowed in the designated campground areas.
- Speed Limit: 5 MPH at all times.
- Smoking is prohibited within the campsite or in the restrooms.
- Fireworks are prohibited.
- No open fires.

Campground Conduct:

- Drinking of Alcoholic beverages are permitted (only) at your campground site (no walking around the property with open containers of alcohol).
- Behavior which disturbs or creates a nuisance for others in the campground or on the premises adjacent thereto is prohibited.
- Violation of Conduct Regulations is cause for immediate termination of camping privileges and/or notification of the proper authorities, at the sole discretion and judgement of the property manager. No refunds of any fees will be required if camping is terminated as a result of violation of the Conduct Regulations.

Garbage Disposal:

- Garbage cans are for campground garbage. (Occupants must carry out everything they have brought into the campground. No Dumping!)

Gray Water/Sewage Disposal - by order of the Island County Health Department:

- There is a gray water dumping station on the north side of the campgrounds...you can utilize these services during your stay (included in your daily fee). If you are using the services alone (not camping overnight) the fee is \$5.00. No Gray water or sewage may be dumped on the grounds (either from holding tank or from containers). A violation of this rule will result in removal from the grounds.

Pet Control:

- Pets must be on a leash at all times; leash should not be longer than eight feet and owner should be in control of the pet at all times.
- Pets are not allowed in any building. Pet owners are responsible to clean up after their pet

Quiet Hours:

- Monday - Sunday 10pm-9am

Restroom Facilities:

- Bathrooms and showers are available for all campers (24 hours per day). These facilities are in the lower part of the fairgrounds. There are no laundry facilities.

Vehicle Limits per Campsite:

- One Car and One Recreational Vehicle per designated space - or
- One Car and Two Tents per designated space

Camping Party size:

- One Camping Party per site - limited to eight people for overnight stay
- Additional vehicles and/or visitor parking spaces are available near the restrooms.

Vehicle Licensing:

- All vehicles, motorhomes and trailers (motorized or not), must be currently registered, licensed, fully operational, and in good working order.
