With the recreational crab season starting, please note that we are at capacity in the Harbor for July 2nd through the 5th. We may not have space available for guests without reservations, so please contact the Harbormaster prior to becoming caught between a rock and a low tide!

Our new D and E docks have been very popular with both visiting boaters and local crabbers/fishermen. In order to accommodate both groups, we have implemented new hours of use on all floating docks. Please observe our need to allow our visiting boaters to have a peaceful night's sleep and a quiet morning.

Public Hours on all floating docks are 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

There will be times during the summer when fishing and crabbing will not be allowed on D and E docks. This will be when we have visiting groups or yacht clubs that require the use of the docks for their group functions and feasts.
