### Port Update:

On-Call Engineer: Met with DCG and JA Brennan on Friday, May 17 and walked the Campground and began discussion on renovations/design concepts. JA Brennan will prepare several different options/layouts for the Campground given our multiple user types and needs (to include using the grass area in the NW corner of the property where the Carnival sets up during Fair). Rough timeline is to have options to review before Christmas with a preferred course of action selected by April 2020 in time for the next round of RCO Grant Application submissions.

**Arena:** Grading, sand addition and rock removal completed (rock removal was not as successful as hoped).

Coffman Kitchen Expansion: The service application to PSE for 3-phase power was signed no May 28. Driftmier notified the Port that submission to the City of Langley for permitting completed on June 10.

Harvest Fest: This October Americana themed festival (3, 4, 5, 6,) will focus on Whidbey grown, local art and vintners. Beekeeping, small gardens, etc. with Stalls and classes will use Wooden Nickels to limit issues with cash management. Some discussion of how to dovetail this with the Scarecrow festival in Fiddle Faddle.

**Creative District**: The stakeholder group for the Langley Creative District filed their intent to apply for Creative District status with the State.

WWGA: (SE) Nothing to report

Would like to continue to work on minimizing Fair turn-around time so tenants can re-occupy spaces sooner.

Arena looks good; it's going to require a lot of water though.

- Presented idea of having the Port provide small pails, and if riders want, offer a "pail of rocks" removed from the arena in lieu of paying the haul-in fee.
- Asked if 811 locates are being maintained and updated on an "as-built" recording plotting survey plans with tracing locates. Also plan ahead in the future and put all utilities under impervious areas and avoid areas where stakes are routinely driven in the ground.

#### Old Business:

Process for naming buildings on Fairgrounds was discussed. A guideline for naming buildings was approved with some modifications. Plaques or markers with history of person building named for was discussed. Request from Fair Association to name the Hope Kitchen and a Horse Barn was discussed.
