- RCED Grant: Has hit a snag but funds should be released soon
- Coffman Kitchen: ADA parking and pathways will be put by entryway. Grass will be removed
- **New Project** undergoing On-Call Engineering development: After learning of a WA Dept of Agriculture \$100K grant possibility, getting cost estimates of gutting restrooms below the port office and replacing with ADA copliant, cipher locks and unisex bathrooms with shower.

Fairgrounds Update: See attached report. Additions:

- **Django Fest:** Ad hoc jam sessions with some food and beverages will be held on site
- Harvest Festival: Cost of \$200/booth appears to be a detriment to signups

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General Roundtable:

South Whidbey Historical Society, Chair: (GG) Nothing to report.

Island County: (HPJ) Not Present

4H: (CMF) Problems with Fair discussed included:

- New 4H year starts Oct 1. 40 youth going to State Fair next month
- Rabbit holes caused several people to tumble. Idea of Predator Perches was brought up. See http://tommy51.tripod.com/perch.html,
 Perches for raptors - eFOTG - USDA
- Doors were left unlocked, need security lock
- Concern voiced over treatment of 4H'ers and the stress of the Fair. Youth can still quality without Fair.
- Concern voiced over live auction timing with the early date of the Fair. Animals not mature enough.

Fair Association: (VK)(JK)

Fair: Investigating concerns voiced by 4H'ers

Naming: Proposal to Port on naming the Small Kitchen/Snack Stand in the Hope Building after Klaus Zuiderbaan and Sally Berry to be submitted. Motion by Virginia Keck, seconded by Dominique Emerson. 7 yes. Additional discussion of single plaque/name verses large, additive design and placement of wording. Also large, painted signs on named space.

Langley Chamber of Commerce: (IM) Not Present

WWGA: (SE)(CW) Horse show lost money but the horse arena was great inspite of rain.

Tenants: (AF) Discussed:

- Investigating of leaving floor in place to reduce move out/in effort
- Parking lots need cleaning after fair as they are greasy and dusty.

• Still need more effort on tenant/fair transitions

At Large: (GH) Echoed concern of 4H and fair interactions.

At Large: (JB) Not Present

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City of Langley: (DE)

- Short term Rental Code passed with caps on whole house and ADUs. Discussion of insurance for renters ensued.
- Infrastructure Project received \$3M grant from County depends on bond approval for \$4M to be decided in November

Old Business:

Process for naming buildings on Fairgrounds was discussed; the guideline for naming buildings was with all modifications approved that include the final approval authority rests with the Port Board of Commissioners. Motion by Gwendy Hastings, seconded by Sharon Edwards. 7 yes

New Business:

Plaque Funding: Continuing discussion on how to fund the plaques/method of marking a building. Need cost estimates of various options.

New Business:

Concerns: Showers and toilets drip water and run continuously, wasting resources and costing money. Rabbits are a huge issue in the hazards they create.
