# Redistricting Requirements


- ▶ District boundaries are required to be reviewed when decennial US Census data is released
- ▶ Consists of a three stage process
  - Stage 1 – Analyze most recent population data
  - Stage 2 – Realignment of districts
  - Stage 3 – Complete the process (Meets and Bounds description)
- ▶ Process must be complete by November 15, 2022
- ▶ Process is driven by RCW 29a.76.010

# Stage 1 - District Analysis

- ▶ 2010 Census population for the district = 14,024
- ▶ 2020 Census population for the district = 16,905
  - Increase of 2,881
  - Ideal population for each district = 5,635
  - Current deviation range across districts is 9.5%
    - District 1 deviation is -4.26%
    - District 2 deviation is -0.98%
    - District 3 deviation is +5.24%
- ▶ Redistricting is required

# Stage 2 - Realignment

- ▶ Each district shall:
  - Be as nearly equal in population as possible
  - Be as compact as possible
  - Geographically contiguous
  - Shall not favor (or disfavor) any racial group or political party
  - To the extent feasible, shall coincide with existing recognized natural boundaries
  - To the extend possible, preserve communities of related and mutual interest

# Stage 2 – Proposal

- ▶ Goal is for realignment to have 2% or less total deviation range across districts
- ▶ Goal is for no district deviation to be more than +/- 1% of the desired population
- ▶ Goal is to preserve communities of related and mutual interest

# Stage 2 – Proposal

- ▶ Deviation range is 1.77%
  - District 1 deviation is +0.35%
  - District 2 deviation is +0.71%
  - District 3 deviation is -1.06%
  
- ▶ Pros
  - Deviation range meets goal
  - Adequately preserve communities of related and mutual interest
  
- ▶ Cons
  - District 3 deviation exceeds goal by 0.06% (negligible)

- ▶ Submit adopted plan to Island County no later than November 15, 2022


# Precinct Map
